MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
April 7, 2021

A Public Hearing on the budget and a special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Northwest Mosquito Abatement District was held 7:00 pm Wednesday, April 7, 2021 at 147 West Hintz Road, Wheeling, IL.

There being a presence of a quorum, Daniel R. Ansani, President called the meeting to order.

A Public Hearing was held at this time on the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the Northwest Mosquito Abatement District for the fiscal year May 1, 2021 to April 30, 2022.

At 7:30 PM on a motion made by the Trustee Russell Nowak and seconded by the Trustee Dale Niweiardowski, the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance was adopted.

**BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF  
THE NORTHWEST MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT  
FOR FISCAL YEAR MAY 1, 2021 TO APRIL 30, 2022**

WHEREAS, DANIEL ANSANI, RAYMOND KINCAID, RUSSELL K. NOWAK, DALE NIEWIARDOWSKI and JAMES THENNISCH have been designated by the Board of Trustees to prepare in tentative form a Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, and on February 17, 2021, such Tentative Budget and Appropriation Ordinance was submitted to and inspected by the Board of Trustees, who thereupon ordered the same filed with the Secretary and ordered the Secretary to make the same conveniently available to public inspection, and the Secretary has made said Tentative Budget and Appropriation Ordinance conveniently available to public inspection for at least thirty (30) days prior to final action thereof; and

WHEREAS, prior to final action, a public hearing was held as to such Budget and Appropriation Ordinance on the 7th day of April 2021, notice of said hearing having been given at least one (1) week prior thereto by publication in the Paddock Publications, Inc., a newspaper regularly published in the District;

**CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATE OF REVENUES  
OF NORTHWEST MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT**

RUSSEL NOWAK, being duly sworn on oath, deposes and states as follows:

1. Affiant is the Treasurer and Chief Financial Officer of the Northwest Mosquito Abatement District.
2. As Treasurer of the Northwest Mosquito Abatement District, Affiant participated in the preparation of the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance and the Tax Levy Ordinance for the fiscal year May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022.
3. Affiant estimates that the total of all revenues to be received by the Northwest Mosquito Abatement District for its appropriation and non-capital fund monies available to the Northwest Mosquito Abatement District for its appropriation for the fiscal year May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022 are as follows:

A.	Cash to be received from State of Illinois Personal Property Replacement Tax.	\$ 100,640.00

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4. Affiant does not anticipate that the Northwest Mosquito Abatement District will receive any other revenues for its appropriation other than as listed in Paragraph 3 of this Certificate, with the exception of interest if monies are deposited temporarily in interest-bearing accounts. The exact amount of such interest cannot be ascertained and would represent only a nominal contribution to its appropriation for the year. The only other monies available are monies previously appropriated pursuant to 70 I.L.S.C. 1005/9.1 for capital improvements which are ongoing and continuing from one year to another.
